The monthly meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Morrison was brought to order, at 8:00 p.m. at the Morrison Town Hall, 3792 Park Rd. Agenda/notice posted June 3, 2009. Present were Chairman, Todd Christensen, Supervisors, Kevin Collins & Ron Lemke, Clerk, Colleen Magley, Treasurer, Nancy Pantzlaff, Zoning Administrator, Joy Koomen, Constable, Dennis Laabs and four residents/observers.

1. Pledge to the flag.
2. Moved by Collins, 2nd by Lemke to approve the Agenda; motion carried. Moved by Lemke to approve the Minutes from May 12, June 2, and May 26, 2009 Board of Review and Town Board meetings, 2nd by Collins; motion carried.
3. Invitation to speak on any Agenda item below; none.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

4. Culvert fee increase - after further discussion, moved by Christensen to increase the culvert fee from \$35.00 to \$50.00 with \$15.00 to be paid to the issuing supervisor, 2nd by Collins; motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

5. Discuss/act on Brown County Planning CSM - after further discussion, moved by Christensen, 2nd by Lemke to request more information from Brown County Planning before Morrison will make any decision on this; motion carried.
6. Class "B" beer and Class "B" liquor license applications have been received from The Coop, Wander Springs, The Evergreen, Wayside Fire Dept, Springers Lanes, Country Crossroads, and De Greef Ends Here. Class "B" liquor license application has been received from Trout Springs Winery. After further review, moved by Lemke to approve all of the liquor licenses applied for, 2nd by Collins; motion carried.
7. Cigarette/tobacco license applications have been received from The Coop, Country Crossroads, The Evergreen and Springers Lanes. After further discussion, moved by Christensen, 2nd by Collins to approve the cigarette/tobacco licenses applied for; motion carried.
8. One-day temporary beer license application has been received from Wayside Morrison Youth Sports for their picnic to be held July 25, 2009 - moved by Christensen, 2nd by Lemke to approve the one-day license; motion carried.
9. Discuss/approve operator license applications received - after review of the 30 applications received, moved by Christensen to approve the operators license, 2nd by Collins; motion carried.
10. Correspondence - Christensen received grant information. The Board discussed the possibility of applying for a grant to be used for bridges and guard rails projects. This needs to be applied for by Aug. 1. Christensen received an email concerning the salt the Town requested. Other correspondence on file.
11. Constable Report - several calls that were taken care of.

12. Treasurers Report – attached. Treasurer also received a complaint on lawns not being maintained, and this violates the nuisance ordinance.
13. Zoning Administrators – attached. Additional comments on a sign that has not been removed. This is in violation of the zoning ordinance. Also discussion on a property that needs to be vacated due to non-compliance with zoning; Way-Mor Park needs an address sign; also a new address and sign is needed for the Wings over Wisconsin property.
14. Open Forum for public input – resident complained of an abandoned house located in Wayside. Several rat nests have been seen behind the house. Board requested photos of this; also the Board will mail letters to several owners of properties that are not properly maintained informing them of their violation of our nuisance ordinance. Music in the park will be held June 10 at 6:30. The intersection of Morrison Road and Park Road is a blind intersection. Resident requests signage there and possible speed reduction. Lemke will check with Rent a flash on what is available for this and costs.
15. Approval of the Payment of bills - after further discussion and review of the presented voucher, moved by Christensen to approve/pay the voucher presented, 2nd by Lemke; motion carried.
16. An item shared by Board Members - Scott Construction is almost finished with roads. Lemke will check on bridges and signs.
17. Moved by Lemke to adjourn, 2nd by Collins; motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:55 p.m.
